ArrowStream Poultry

USDA young chicken harvest was 162.7 million head, which was lower by 2.4% w/w but was down just slightly compared to the same week last year. Breaking out the segment, the National Composite whole birds and WOGs were flat w/w at \$1.25/lb. Looking at the parts, the white meat segment was higher. Boneless/skinless breasts were up another \$0.16 w/w to \$1.92/lb, and tenderloins were up \$0.04 \$1.73/lb. Retail promotions were a lot higher again for chicken breasts, and retail prices at the grocery store were a bit lower compared to the prior week. Chicken wings were actually down \$0.11 w/w at \$1.78/lb, but drumsticks were flat at \$0.47/lb. Boneless/skinless thigh meat was higher by \$0.08 to \$1.45/lb, while the B/I thighs were down \$0.05 at \$0.87/lb. In the turkey segment, the harvest is down 12% y/y and prices are a lot higher. Boneless breast prices were up 2% last week, while B/I whole turkeys were higher by 12% w/w. The USDA's large eggshell index was higher by 1.5% w/w. Looking ahead, the federal government announced plans to purchase eggs from other nations as part of a five-pronged strategy, and price increases have slowed the past two weeks. Retalitory tariffs by Canada and Mexico could actully help lower prices for chicken parts here in the U.S. FOB per pound except when noted.
