Produce

Avocados were probably last week's biggest highlight out of the core group of produce items after the 48-count hass price average extended its losing streak to six straight weeks. The slow but steady downturn has come despite pre-Cinco de Mayo positioning, and now that we're past the holiday demand season, prices will likely continue to trend sideways to slightly lower. We still probably won't have a shot at returning to the normal sub-\$50/carton area until after June, though. Yellow onions were another highlight after the 50 lb. price average climbed slightly www for the first time in over a year. This is around the time of year when yellow onions typically bottom out before turning higher through the end of June, so if prices are going to escape the rut they've been in since Q3 last year, now's the time. Ultimately, though, \$10/sack is probably as high as the short-term ceiling goes for the moment. 25 lb. large roma tomatoes climbed another 2.8% w/w, but that was a much slower rate of gain than the previous two weeks. We're now entering the typical quiet season for tomatoes so hopefully prices will remain stable from here through July. Price bases noted below.
